**Bouygues Telecom concludes sales agreement
with Digicel for Bouygues Telecom Caraïbe**

Bouygues Telecom signed a sales agreement on Friday 28 April 2006 in Paris with Caribbean operator Digicel for 100% of the capital of subsidiary Bouygues Telecom Caraïbe for €155 million. Following approval from the French telecommunications regulator (Autorité de Régulation des communications électroniques et des postes), all the conditions precedent have been met.

This agreement was reached following exclusive negotiations between Bouygues Telecom and Digicel announced on 8 March 2006.

Thanks to the deal, Bouygues Telecom Caraïbe customers and staff will benefit from the synergies of a fast-growing group in the region.

Created in December 2000, Bouygues Telecom Caraïbe has over 160,000 customers and generated sales of €117 million in 2005.
