Bouygues Telecom introduced its i-mode service in 2002, becoming the first operator in France to offer unlimited mobile internet service for its customers. The i-mode portable has helped popularise mobile internet use thanks to a rate plan that reflects customer expectations for easy access, simple navigation, clear, one-off charges and Web content from top-tier partners.

The new **Web & Mail** offers from Bouygues Telecom make mobile internet available to everyone and on all mobile phones.

Receive personal email directly on your mobile phone

A very significant majority of mobile internet users want to be able to access their personal email inbox from their mobile phones¹.

As from 2 April 2008, all Bouygues Telecom customers (including those with locked phones and prepay plans) will have **free**, **unlimited access to personal email** right from their mobile phones (via webmail or a compatible address provided by their Internet Service Provider). The messages are sent to the mobile phones using a push email service. The new service includes attachments of up to 300KB.

The service will be available with all 12 Bouygues Telecom phones (see page 3) as well as compatible phones on the market equipped with integrated email software.




Customers will be able to **configure their mobile email online.** This simple configuration interface gets the mobile email service up and running in just a few clicks.

As of 3 March, the **Web & Mail Option** gives customers with Bouygues Telecom call plans unlimited mobile internet use, including sending and receiving emails with attachments. Customers will have several options for mobile Web surfing:


