- Users can also connect to preloaded content on the card and browse the content provider's site in one click.

A 256MB microSD<sup>™</sup> TrustedFlash<sup>™</sup> memory card comes free with the Samsung Z650i mobile phone pack. The card can hold more than 250<sup>(1)</sup> songs – about 12 hours of music – or more than 800<sup>(2)</sup> high-resolution photos. With the memory card, mobile phones are transformed into full-fledged mobile multimedia players.

Content providers can use the secure card to propose new premium content while enjoying protection against piracy. For example, they can preload content on cards to attract consumers to their website, without them having to enter a web address. Three titles from the Universal catalogue are included with the Z650i phone.
