
Special features for Bouygues Telecom Entreprises customers

The application enables instant access to AFP news, including images, with a choice of four languages. Dozens of different themes are available, ranging from international news to offbeat stories, business, politics, sport and entertainment.

Bouygues Telecom Entreprises has pre-selected six basic sections for its business customers: Front Page, Business, High Tech, France, World and Sport.

Users can also personalize their home page to display news that reflects their interests by selecting their own subjects. They can also choose the language—French, English, Spanish or German. The application has different display levels, ranging from summaries of top stories in a few lines to complete stories or photos corresponding to news items.
