It will also favour the emergence of young talent by offering winners of the New Albums for Young Architects and Landscape Designers (NAJAP) competition opportunities to realise their projects.

The first project to benefit from the Foundation's support is an awareness-raising initiative, the *Habiter Écologique* exhibition held at the Cité de l'Architecture et du Patrimoine from 13 May to 1 November. Seeking to make both professionals and users more aware of sustainable and responsible lifestyles, the exhibition features eco-responsible alternatives to the traditional one-family dwelling as well as ideas for eco-housing.
